As previously communicated, UPS must transmit electronic Master Air Waybill (MAWB) and House Air Waybill (HAWB) data to certain destination Customs authorities in advance of arrival. UPS incurs additional costs to maintain compliance with these regulations. Effective December 1, 2014, Argentine Customs will require all airlines to present their flight manifest information to the local Customs office in Buenos Aires, Argentina, four hours prior to aircraft arrival. In addition to the normal MAWB and HAWB required data elements, Argentine Customs is also requesting the IATA Harmonized Tariff Code and Consignee Tax ID. This new requirement is applicable regardless of origin, interline status, service or commodity. UPS requests that these data elements be placed in the Accounting box on your MAWB (and HAWB if the shipment is a consolidation).

At this time, UPS Air Cargo is only accepting this data required by Argentine Customs on the paper MAWB and HAWB. UPS is not accepting this data electronically.

Effective December 1, 2014, UPS will assess a \$15 USD Advanced Manifest Fee per each MAWB destined to Argentina.

As additional countries adopt similar Customs requirements, UPS will be required to evaluate extending the Advanced Manifest Fee to those destinations when warranted.
