CARGOLUX ADAPTS FUEL SURCHARGE

Boca Raton, 13 August 2012 - Cargolux reacts to a recent increase in fuel prices and adapts its fuel surcharge as of 27 August 2012 for shipments ex North America. The decision reflects the increased costs that Cargolux will be exposed to.

The current level of the fuel surcharge will be adjusted to USD 1.25 or CAD 1.25 per kilo. The level of the adjustment in other currencies will be communicated on request by the local Cargolux Sales representatives. The charge is based on actual weight and will be implemented according to local legislation and wherever it is legally permitted.

As a reminder, effective February 1st 2007, Cargolux discontinued assessing a risk surcharge.
